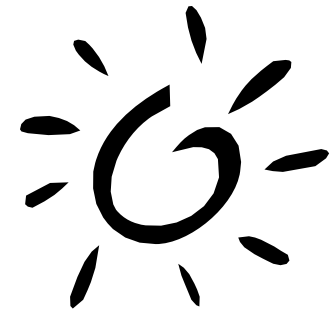

Play Therapy

- Communicate more effectively with your child

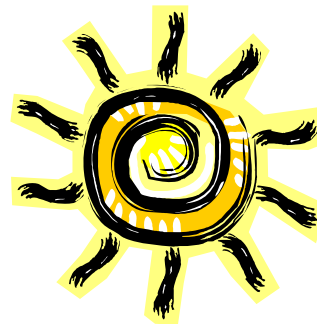
ACCELERATE PROGRAMS

Pre-School Second Step

This is a violence prevention program which promotes the development of positive feelings, self-control, problem solving and anger management skills.

Every Person Influences Children (EPIC)

EPIC is a program which offers parents a chance to meet in a group setting to discuss parenting issues and improve their skills in dealing with children.



Auburn-Cayuga County Emotional Learning & ReAdiness To Excel (ACCELERATE) is a program offered through the Partnership for Results as a result of secured funding from the **Early Learning Opportunities Act Discretionary Grant (ELOA)**. This program will provide an innovative continuum of evidence-based programs and services.
