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Intensive Supervision Conditional Discharge

What is Intensive Supervision Conditional Discharge (ISCD)?

- A Court monitored community-based alternative to out of home placement for youth aged 7 to 16 years
- A collaborative treatment and case management approach for the offender and offender's family
- A continuous (up to 1 year) and intensive supervision program for the offender focusing on positive reintegration into home, school and community through individualized program planning
- A proven method for reducing the offender's future involvement in the criminal justice system and making lasting and positive change
- An assurance of community safety while offender gains the opportunity to remain within the family and the community

What does ISCD do?

- Comprehensive case planning designed to meet individual needs of offender and offender's family in a continuous, long-term mode
- Home-based supervision and counseling for full duration of conditional discharge with up to daily intervention with offender and offender's family
- A variety of forms of individual, group and family counseling matched to meet the needs of the offender and the offender's family
- Provides special funding to support counseling goals and outcomes
- Case management support and advocacy for offender's reintegration into home, school and community
- Creates opportunities for youth achievement and decision-making within the supervision process

- 24 hour crisis management for the offender and offender's family

Typical ISCD conditions may include:

- Compliance with all laws and ordinances
- Daily school attendance and compliance with all school rules
- Compliance with house rules
- Regular meetings with ISCD staff, both individual, family, and group
- Compliance with substance use/alcohol treatment and follow through with all treatment recommendations including inpatient rehabilitation programs
- No travel outside Cayuga County without consent of ISCD staff and guardians
- Attend all ISCD related functions and social events
