This system is accessible by police administrators, who are able to track officers' activities and the effects of their work. Senior school officials for each school and the central office may be

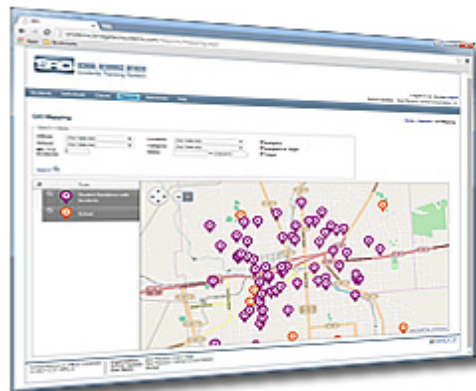

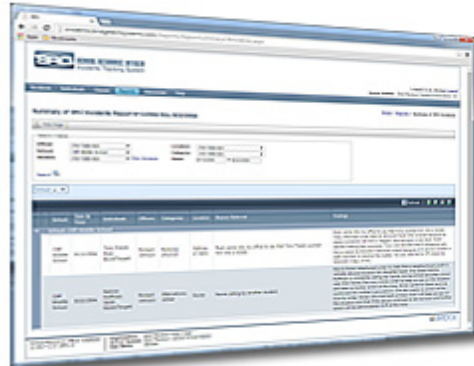

SRO Incidents Tracking System

In the SRO Database, each officer records a wide range of information about specific interventions and incidents on a systematic and ongoing basis. One or more individuals can be identified as instigators, targets, or both for a particular misbehavior or incident. The application allows the SRO to associate multiple individuals per incident in any target/instigator combination. The data entered for each incident include:

- ◆ Date and time of the incident
- ◆ Location of the event
- ◆ Name of the School Resource Officer
- ◆ Who referred the incident to the SRO
- ◆ Individuals involved in the incident
- ◆ Identification of each individual as instigator, target or both
- ◆ Categorization of the incident using one or more predefined categories
- ◆ Lengthy narrative areas for describing the incident:
 - ◆ Reason student was referred to SRO
 - ◆ Details of the investigation
 - ◆ Corrective/referral actions
- ◆ Criminal charges as appropriate based on the state and/or local penal law.



SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER Incidents Tracking System

The SRO Database relies on student directory information obtained from the school district to be recorded either:

- ◆ At the time of incident based on the students involved in the incident, or
- ◆ From a master file of all students in the school district. If the school district shares their directory information with the SROs, the system has a secure and automatic mechanism for loading maintaining the student data.

The SRO Database allows for different features based on the authority level of the user. All users (system administrators and end users) may:

- ◆ Enter and maintain information about each incident.
- ◆ Look up and query data relating to some or all incidents in the database.
- ◆ Look up and query data relating to some or all individuals in the database.
- ◆ Review and print reports. The application provides the user the ability to enter relevant criteria to generate the following reports:
 - Summary of SRO Incidents
 - Pie Chart of SRO Incidents Categories
 - Classes Taught by SROs
 - Students with Incidents (Report displaying student information, school, grade and the number of incidents that each individual has been involved in).
- ◆ Track and manage classes taught by the SROs:
 - Who taught the class;
 - Date class was taught
 - Subject matter of the class
 - When and where the class was taught
 - Class Comments.
